COVID vaccine Safe. Effective. Available.





After initially decreasing in early 2021, adolescent hospitalization rates for COVID-19 increased during March-April

During January-March 2021:



hospitalizations assessed*

Nearly 1/3
required
ICU admission



5% equired mechanical ventilation None died

* Age 12-17 years identified through the COVID-NET surveillance system (https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/covid-data/covid-net/purpose-methods.html)

Adolescents age 12-17 years are now eligible to get a COVID-19 vaccine

Vaccination:

- Protects against severe illness
- Allows kids to safely join group activities
- Is safe and free

It's not over yet.

Rate of disease remains high in unvaccinated individuals.

The kids need protection.

Rates in unvaccinated children are climbing as restrictions are lifting.

Kids and COVID

VERY LOW RISK OF SIGNIFICANT ILLNESS

4 M cases and 327 deaths (AAP.org)

LONG-TERM EFFECTS ARE NOT KNOWN

Long-COVID syndrome and persisting symptoms

KIDS HARBOR AND TRANSMIT VIRUS

The pandemic will not be over until children get immunity.

HIGHLY EFFECTIVE

Real-world data shows over 94% protection. cdc.gov

REACTOGENIC

Most common side effects: arm soreness, fatigue, headache, chills, fever. cdc.gov

MRNA TECHNOLOGY

NEW, BUT NOT UNKNOWN

mRNA science has been developing for decades.

EUA

Pfizer/BioNTech - 12+yo Moderna - 18+yo

Pfizer vaccine is protective against variants of concern.



MYTHS

MRNA vaccines do not alter DNA, do not cause infertility, and are not expected to have long-term side effects.
